 that would teach young people various work skills and provide additional assistance
 for the borough. A Koppel Cares Workforce could be established with these workers
 to assist residents with allowable clean up projects via an application process.
 Additionally, one clerical worker would be requested to assist our secretary with
 filing, organization, scanning, and other administrative duties.
- Rick Milligan, maintenance supervisor, to present a Koppel Clean Up Day which may
 offer paid services like yard debris haul away or removal of construction waste, tires,
 TVs, and other items not customarily accepted by Young's Refuse.
- Dissemination of a Spring newsletter/bulletin to remind residents of applicable ordinances (including yard maintenance, garbage disposal, basketball hoop

registration), clean up services (Koppel Cares Workforce and proposed item haul away day), and updates about the emerging Fire District.
